Northern Territory Under 17's test NSW in day 2 of national championships

Northern Territory Under 17's took on New South Wales in the first of their 50 over matches at Woodville Oval. NSW won the toss and sent NT into bat on a flat wicket.

NT lost Paul Allen early and this brought Gavin Lycett to the crease.

Lycett and Arnout Faveere combined for a valuable 51 run partnership until Lycett was dismissed for 13 (31 balls).

Faveere was joined by Paul Carbone and these two advanced the NT score to 114.

Faveere was in fine touch until he was dismissed for 70 runs from 94 balls.

Brad Zanker joined Carbone and they combined for another important partnership of 36 runs to take NT to 3-150.

Unfortunately, Carbone was run out and his dismissal saw a collapse with NT losing 7-36 and committing the cardinal sin of being dismissed in the 43rd over for 186.

The NT bowlers started slowly with NSW dominating early.

NSW started strongly before two quick wickets from Pat Gallow, saw NSW slump to 3-55 with Matt Wall taking the other wicket.

The NT spin attack of Wall, Joel Bock and Thomas Andrews applied pressure but NSW ultimately claimed victory 5-187 off 39.4 overs, claiming a bonus point.

Wall continued his fine form with the ball to end up conceding 1-15 from his 10 overs and he was ably supported by Andrews (1-23 from 5 overs).

NT take on Victoria tomorrow in the second of its one day matches.
